### HOW WILL I CAST MY BALLOT ONLINE?

- Go to the NASN Web site, [www.nasn.org](http://www.nasn.org).
- Look for the NASN Election icon and click it.
- Login when prompted.
- Click **2010 NASN Election**.
- Follow the ballot instructions.



### HOW WILL I REQUEST A PAPER BALLOT?

- If you would prefer a paper ballot to be mailed to you, please send request via e-mail to Devin Dinkel at [ddinkel@nasn.org](mailto:ddinkel@nasn.org).
- Subject line: REQUESTING A PAPER BALLOT. Include your name, address, and NASN ID.
- Paper ballots will be mailed out in early March.

**NOTE:** If you request a paper ballot, you will be unable to vote online.

### HELPFUL HINTS:

- Only currently paid members having Active or Honorary classification will be eligible to vote.
- The candidates' data and statement of view will be available as a link on the ballot if you haven't had time to review these ahead of time.
- Once you submit your ballot, you will have the opportunity to print it for your records.
- If you requested a paper ballot, one will be mailed to you and you will be unable to vote online.
- Electronic voting will close promptly at midnight on April 15<sup>th</sup>. Paper ballots shall be received in the NASN office no later than April 15<sup>th</sup> in order to be counted.
