SCASN Recognition Awards – Check Appropriate Award Nomination

Recognition Awards

- 1. To recognize organizations or individuals who have continually supported or uniquely contributed to SCASN, school nursing or school health services nationally in at least the last five years.
- 2. To recognize an individual who has given outstanding service to SCASN within the last 5 years.

Award Criteria:

- The proposed candidate must meet one of the above objectives.
- Data substantiating the objectives must accompany the nomination of the candidate.
- Example: Descriptions

(1) Outstanding services to SCASN, special project(s), programs for school nursing/child health and

(2) Describe how SCASN benefited.

- Officers, Board of Directors, and SCASN members will be asked submit candidates to the SCASN Vice President.
- Current Executive Committee members are not eligible to receive an award except for the President's Recognition Award.
- If a corporation is nominated to receive this award, then one person must be selected to appropriately represent the corporation and accept the award for the exemplary contributions of the corporation.

<u>Media Journalist Award</u>

- 1. To recognize an individual or news service that has supported or uniquely contributed to SCASN, school nursing, or school health services through the media in the past year.
- To recognize writers who effectively give audiences a greater awareness and understanding of the importance and value of school nursing through the media.
 Award Selection Criteria
 - Story content is accurate, relevant, and creative.
 - Storyline has a positive major impact on public opinion or policy.
 - Storyline has made school health issues relevant to new audiences.
 - Storyline shows careful research and balanced fair reporting.

Lillian Wald Award

1. To recognize a legislator or public policy official who has supported or uniquely contributed to SCASN, school nursing, or school health services.

Award Selection Criteria

- The individual has effectively advanced legislation or public policy during the past year in areas of importance to school nursing.
- The committee may choose more than one recipient for the recognition awards if it is determined that two or more candidates of equal merit.
